## Pesach 2021

**Important: Do not discontinue use of any medicine without consulting with your doctor and Rabbi.**

- All non-chewable prescription pill medications may be taken on Pesach. (This does not include vitamins and supplements.)
- Liquid, chewable or OTC medications that may contain chometz should only be used under the direction of a doctor and Rabbi.
- Liquid, chewable or OTC medications that contain kitniyos (see below) may be consumed by someone who is ill.
- An otherwise healthy person, who would like to consume a liquid, chewable or OTC medicine to relieve a minor discomfort, should only do so if the product is known to be free of kitniyos.

The following are some chometz-free Over-the Counter medications:

- **Advil** - Caplets, coated (not including Film-coated), Gel caplets
- **Aleve** - Blue Pill (not the blue capsule), Aleve PM, Aleve Back and Muscle Pain, Aleve-D Sinus and Cold
- **Alka Seltzer** - Lemon-Lime Effervescent Tablets, Original Effervescent Tablets
- **Allegra** - Allegra-D 12 hr, Allegra-D 24 hr
- **Bayer Aspirin** – All varieties
- **Benadryl** - Children's allergy liquid, Children's dye-free liquid, Children's Allergy Chewable (grape flavor), Allergy Ultratab Tablets
- **Bicarbonate of Soda** – All brands
- **Chapstick** - Classic Original, Medicated Stick, Moisturizer Stick
- **Claritin** - Claritin-D Tablets
- **Dramimine** - Dramimine Orange, Dramimine Original Formula, Dramimine Less Drowsy
- **Miralax** - Regular Powder
- **Motrin** - IB Caplets, PM Coated Caplets, Children's Liquid, Infant's Liquid
- **Pepto Bismol** - Original Liquid
- **Philips** - Milk of Magnesia – Original
- **Tylenol** - Children's Suspension, Infant's Oral suspension, Regular Strength Tablets, Extra Strength Caplets
